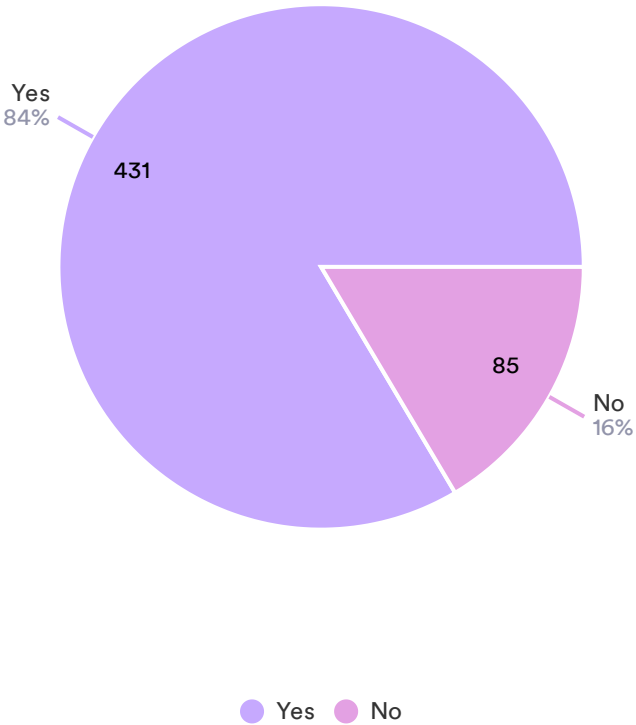

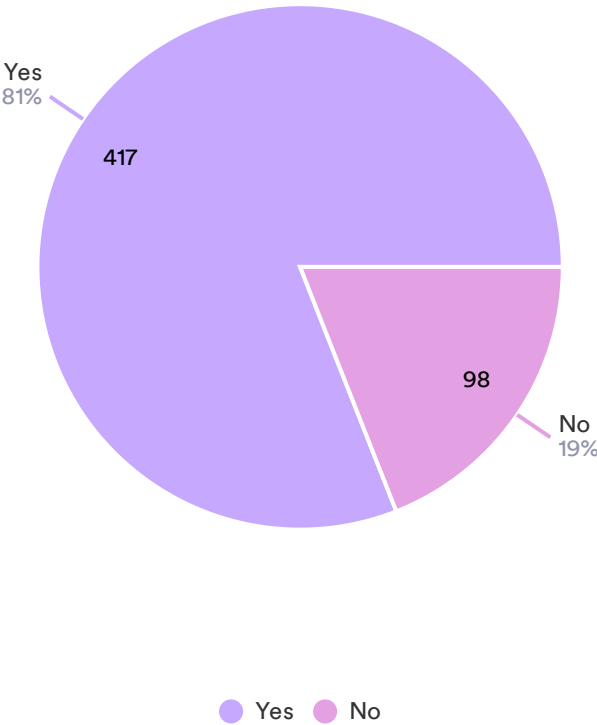
Do you think the village looks attractive?

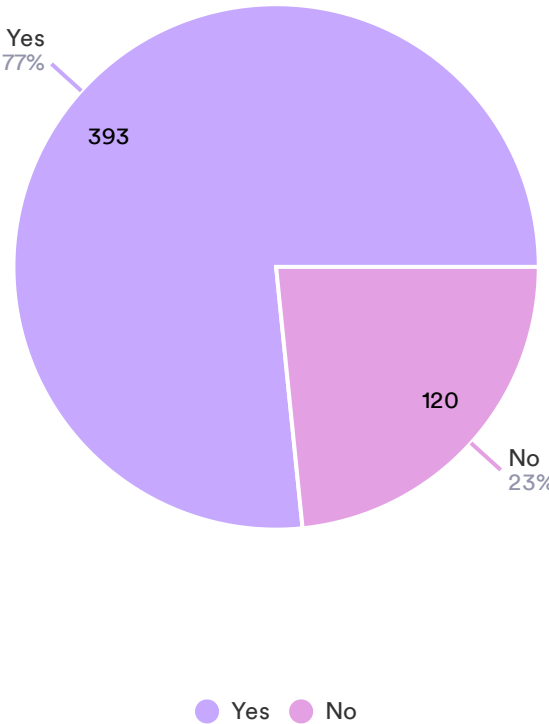
Do you think the village is kept clean and tidy?

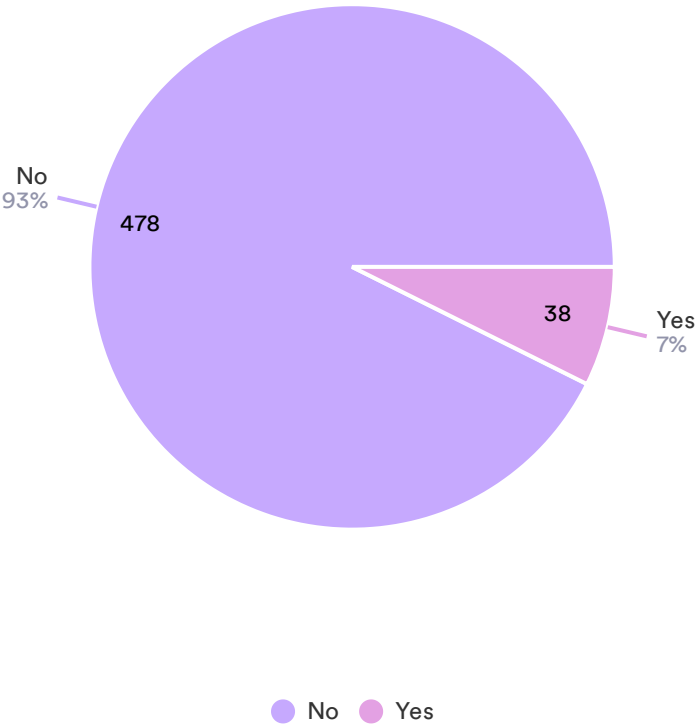

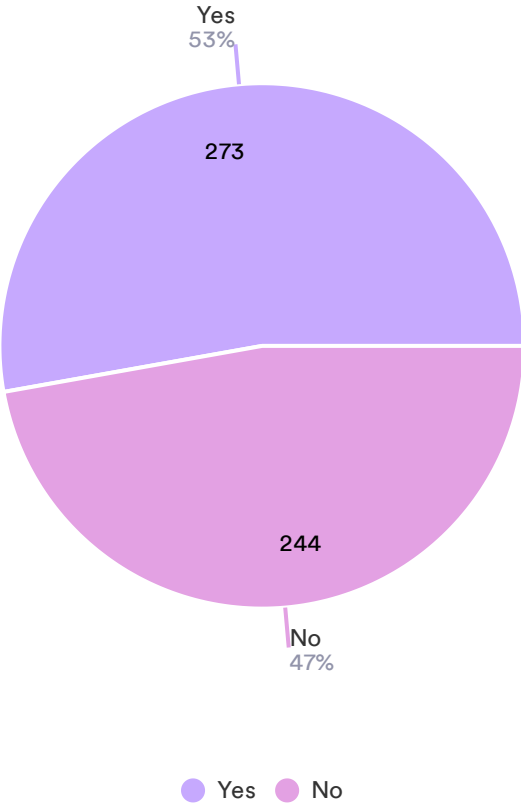
Do you use the mobile library in the village?

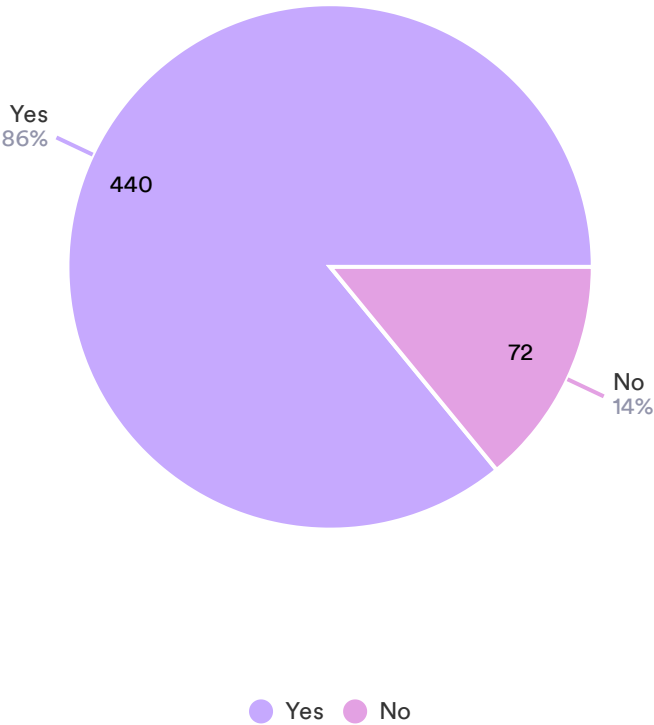
Do you use the post office van in the village?

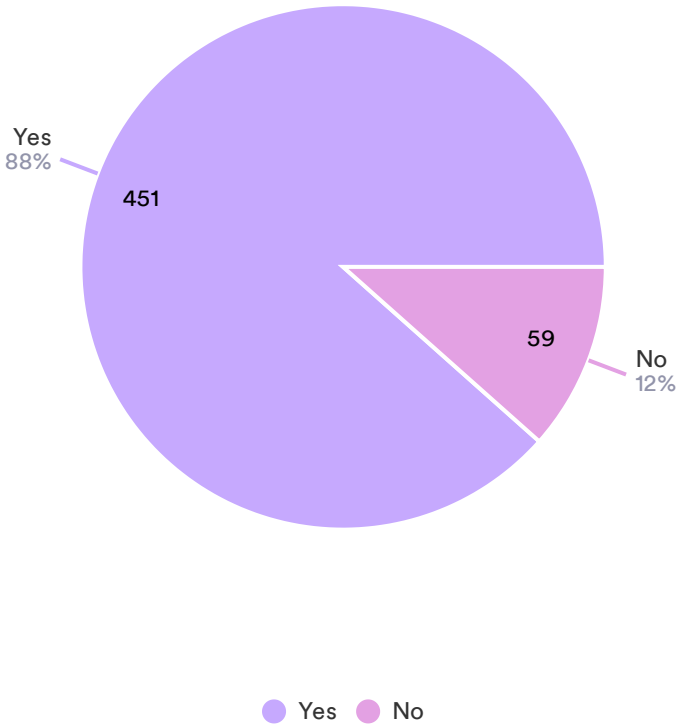

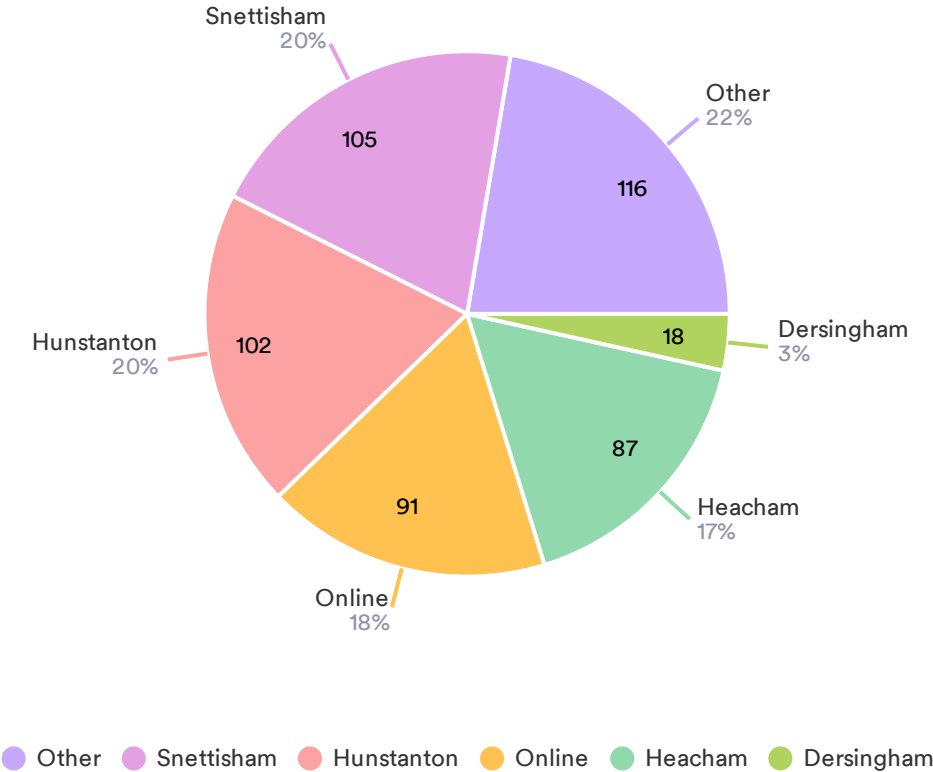
Would you use a regular farmers market in the village?

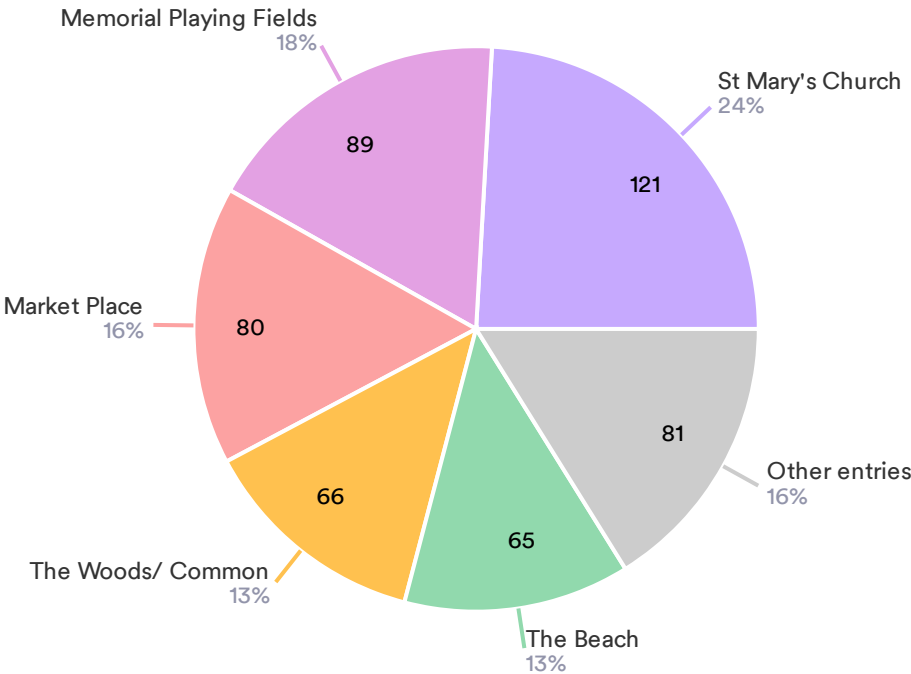
Where do you currently do your grocery shopping?

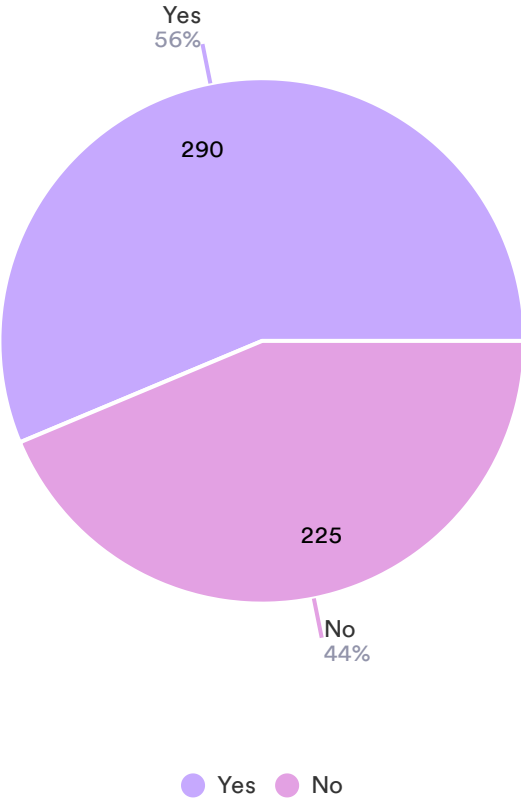
What do you feel is the most important asset of the village?

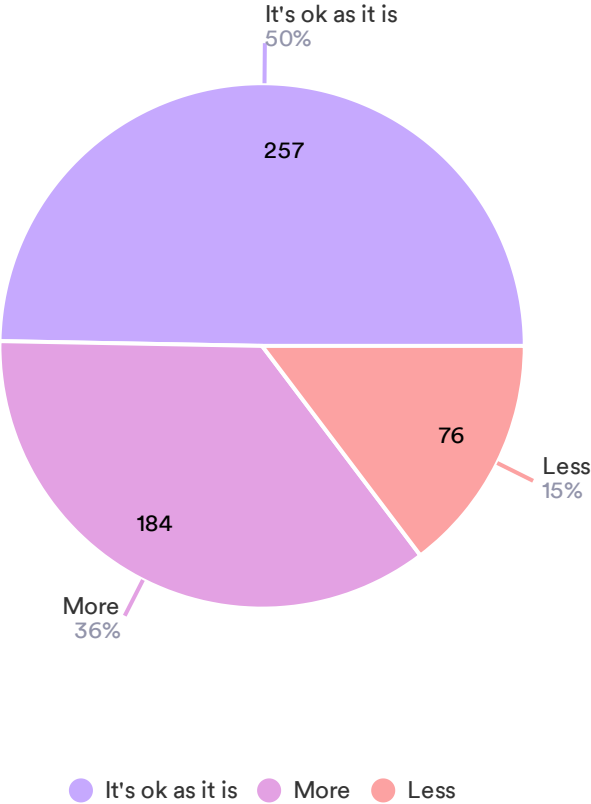
Do you visit the Beach regularly?

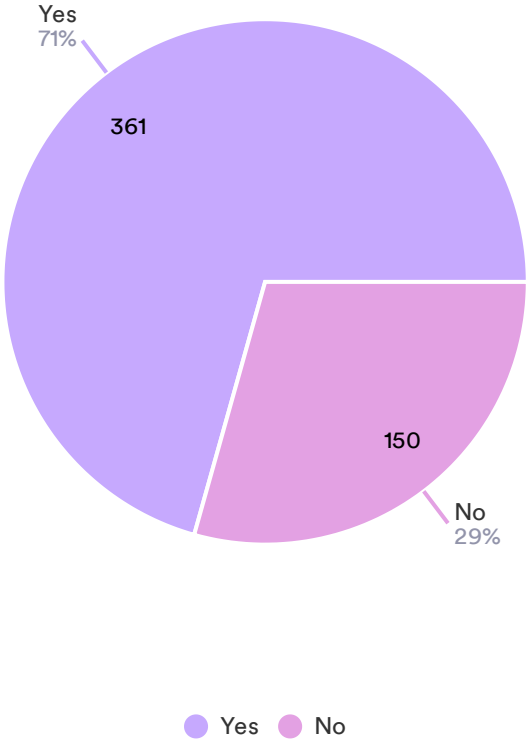
Are you in favour of attracting more or less tourism in the village?

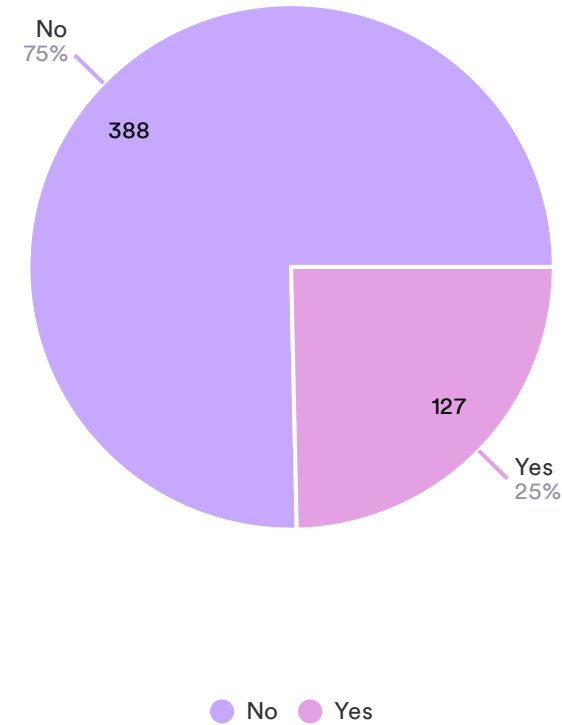
Do you visit the woods/ common regularly?

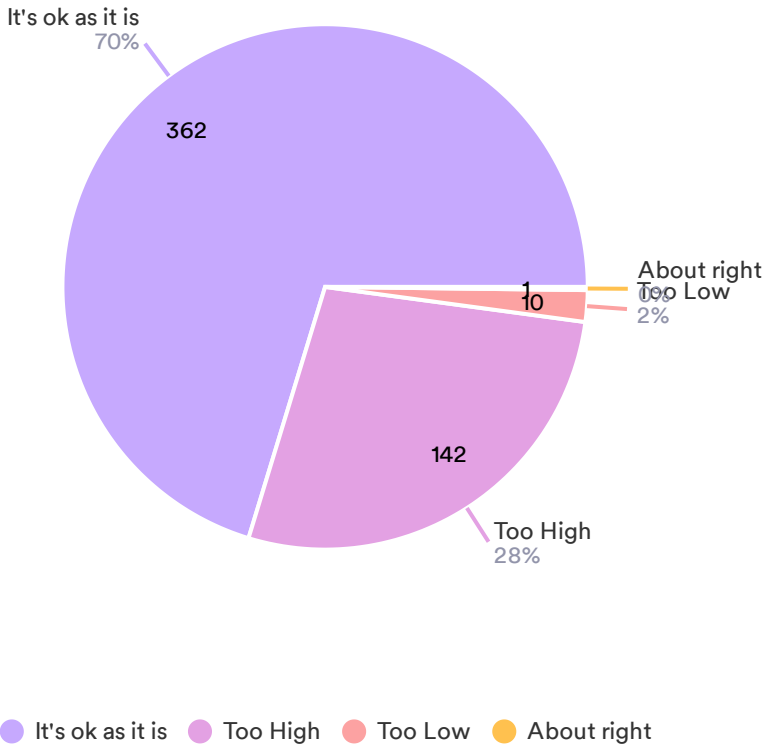
Do you use the Memorial Hall regularly?

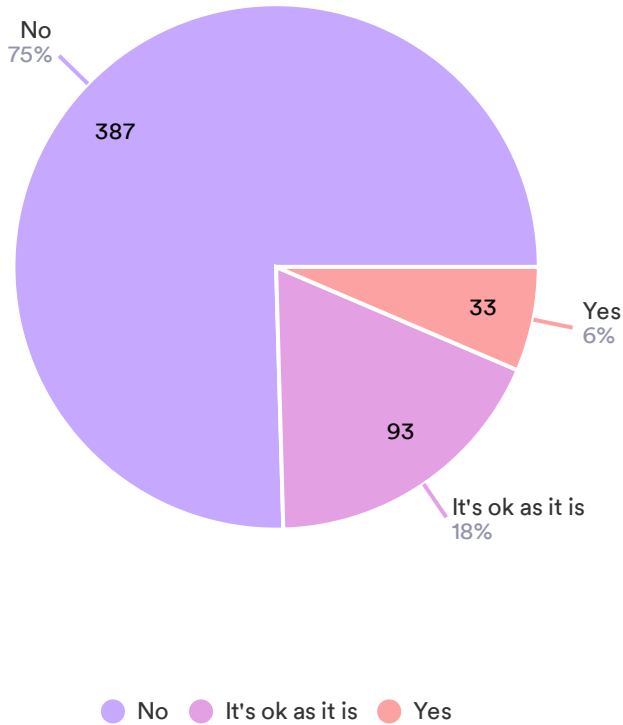
Do you think the speed limit in the centre of the village is

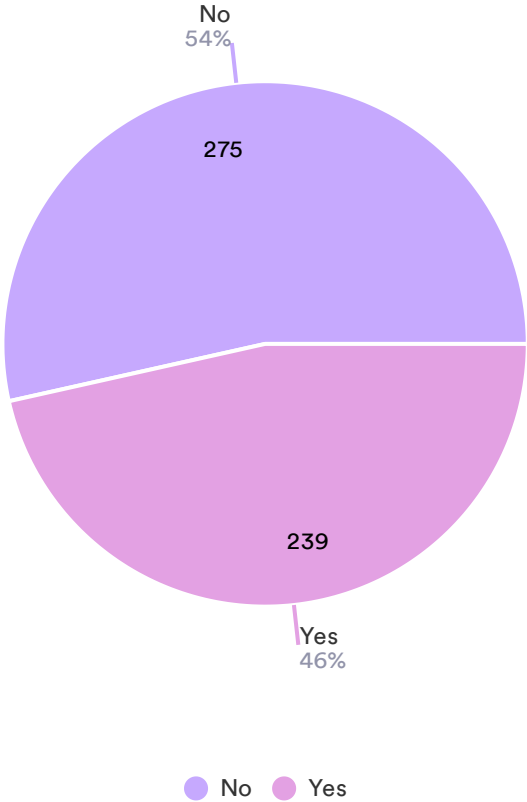

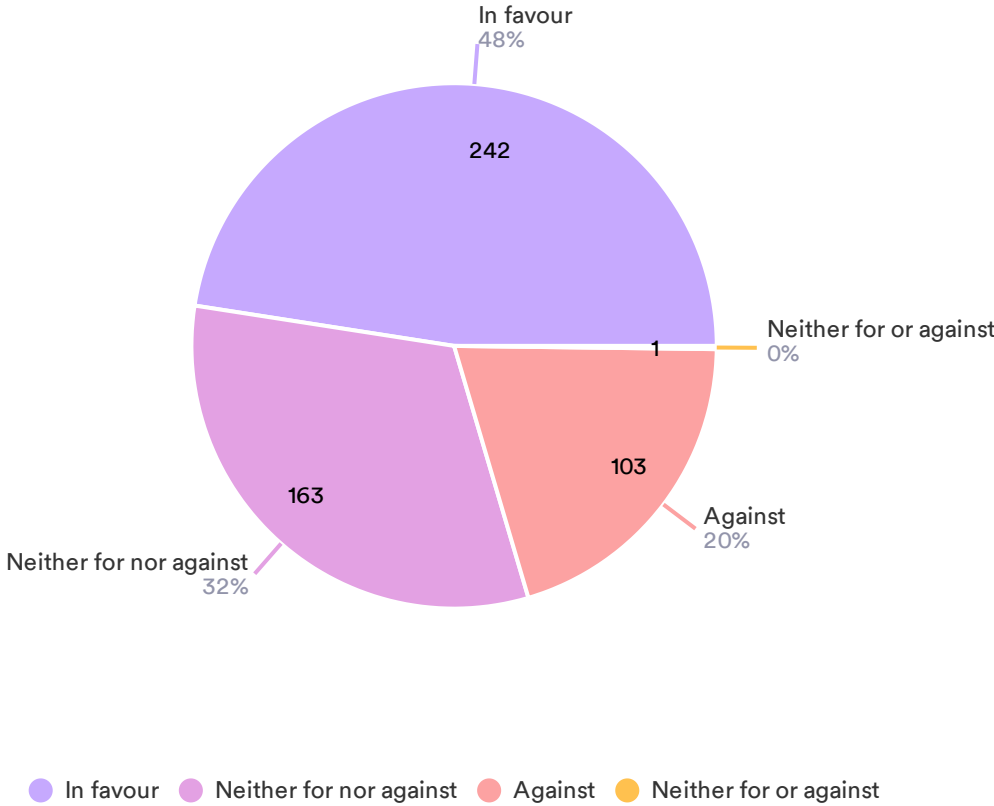
What recreational facilities do you feel are missing from the village?

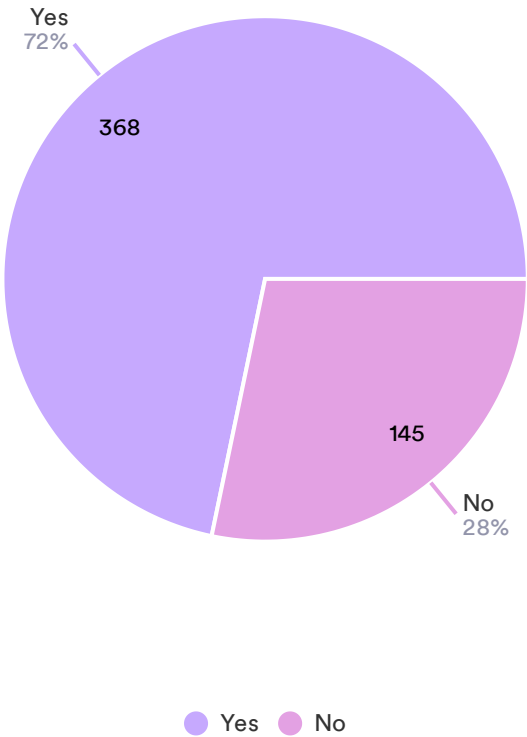
Are you in favour, or against the Pavilion project?

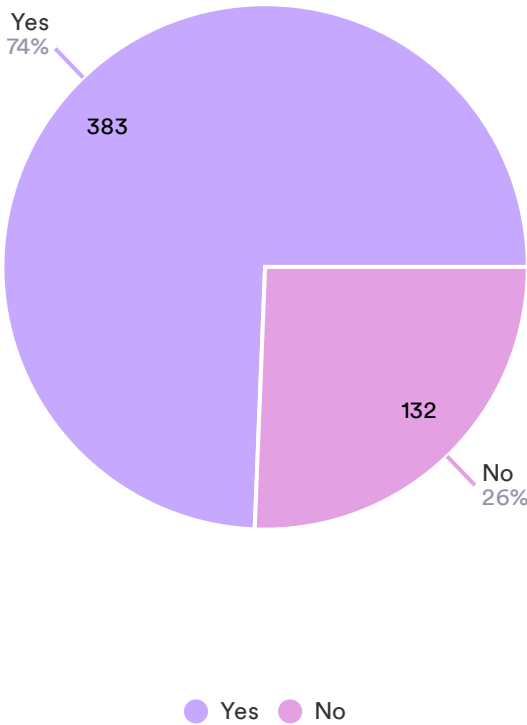
Do you think the street lights provide adequate illumination?

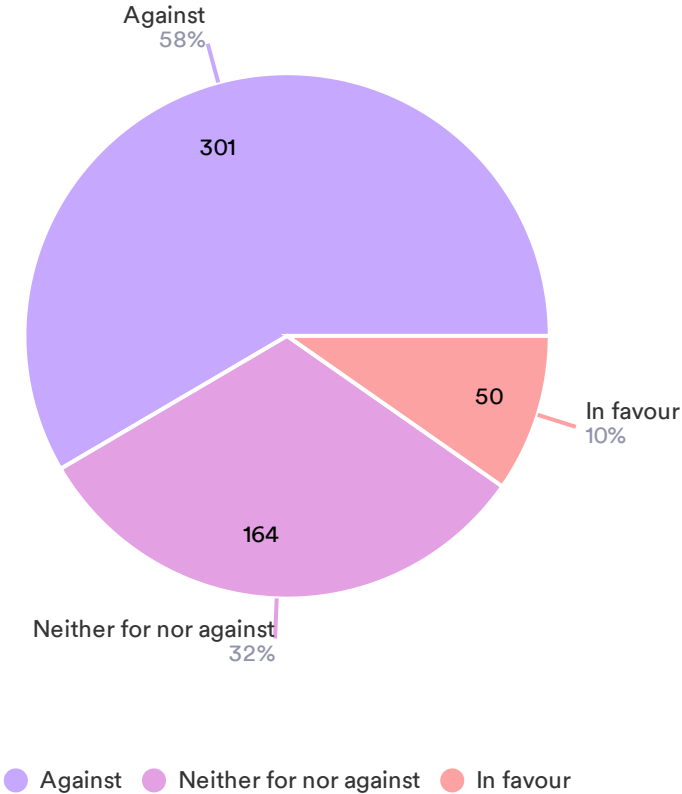
Would you support the street lights being turned off during the night between 1am-4am to save on energy consumption?

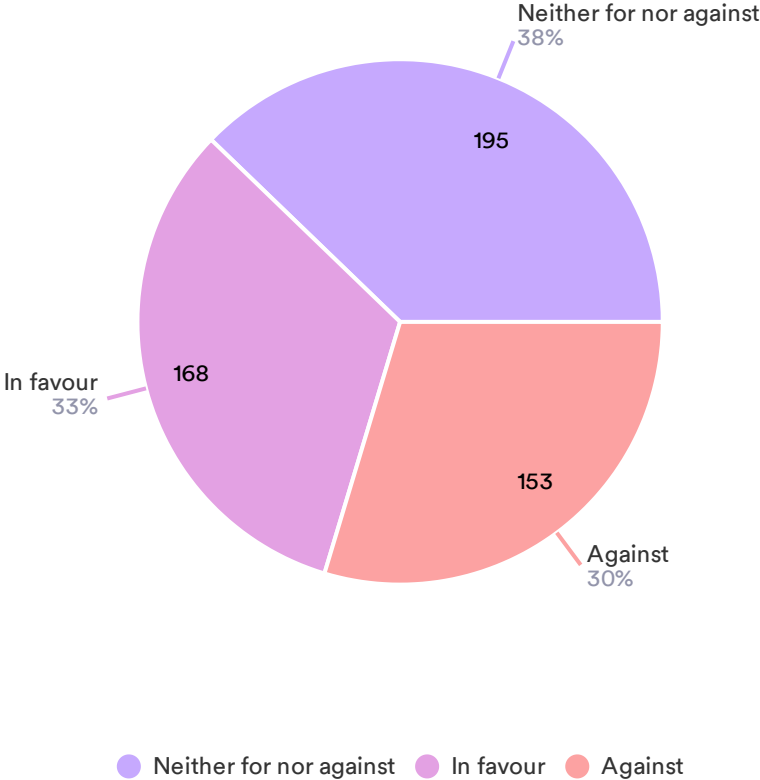
Are you in favour, or against second homes in the village?

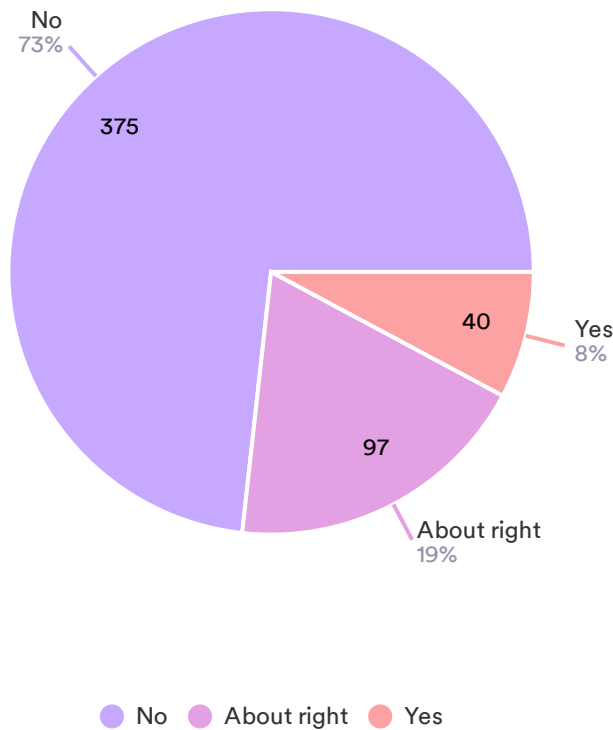
Are you in favour, or against holiday lets in the village?

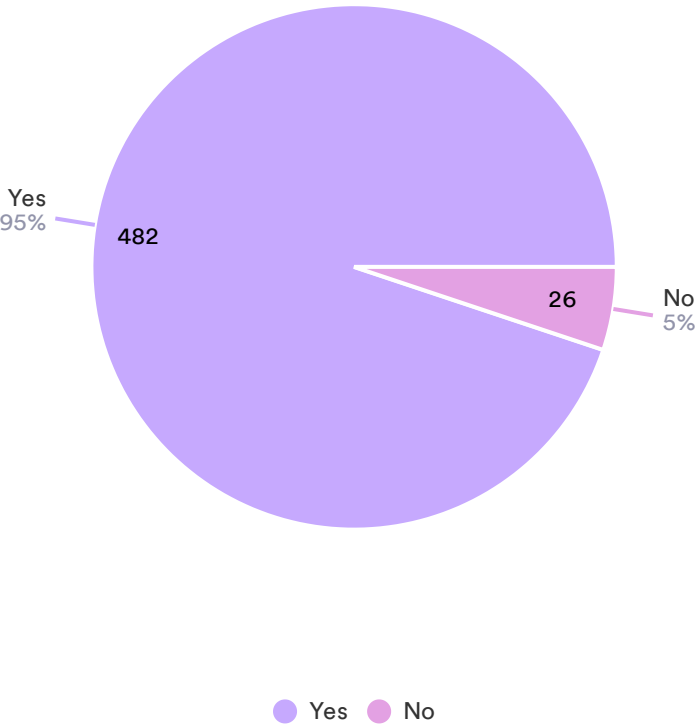
Do you feel the village has sufficient affordable housing?

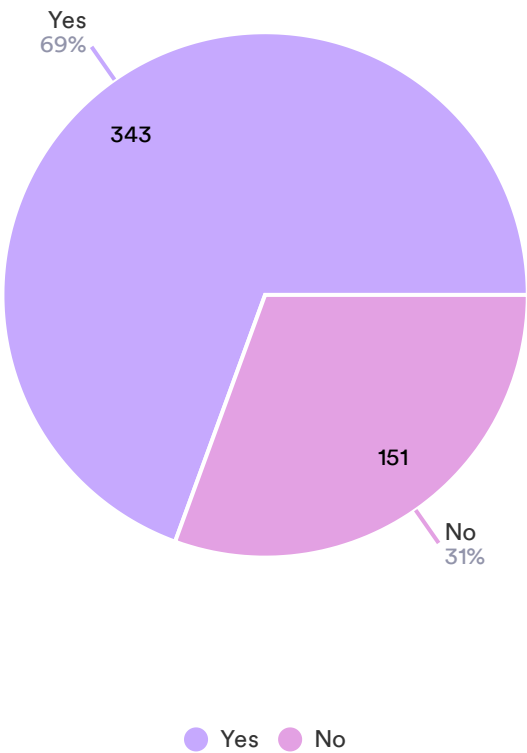
What do you think the parish council could do to improve quality of life in the village?

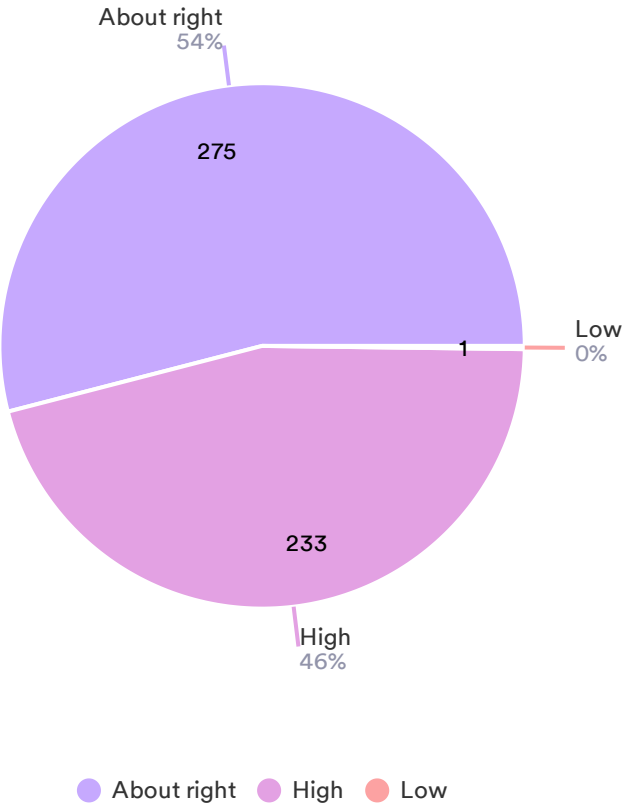

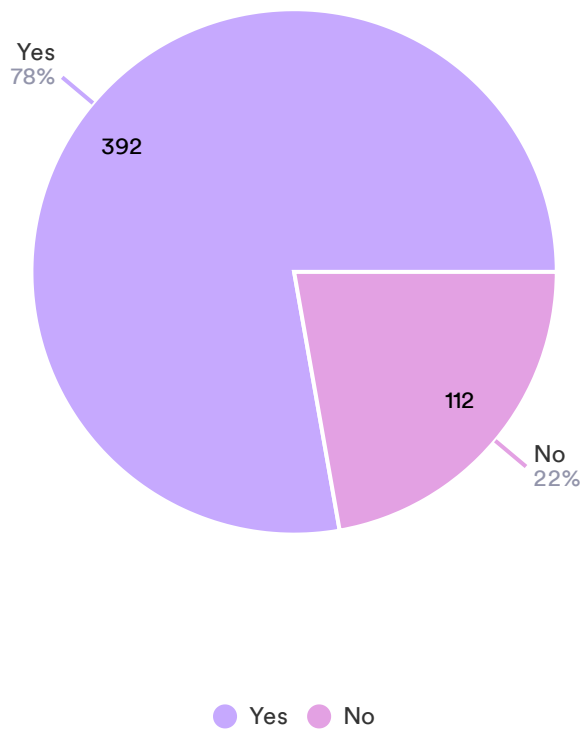
Do you think your council tax is

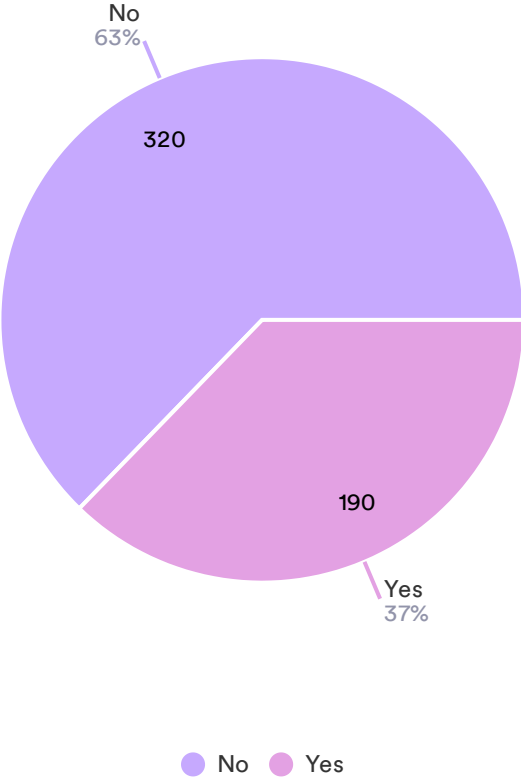
Would you like more communication from the Parish Council?

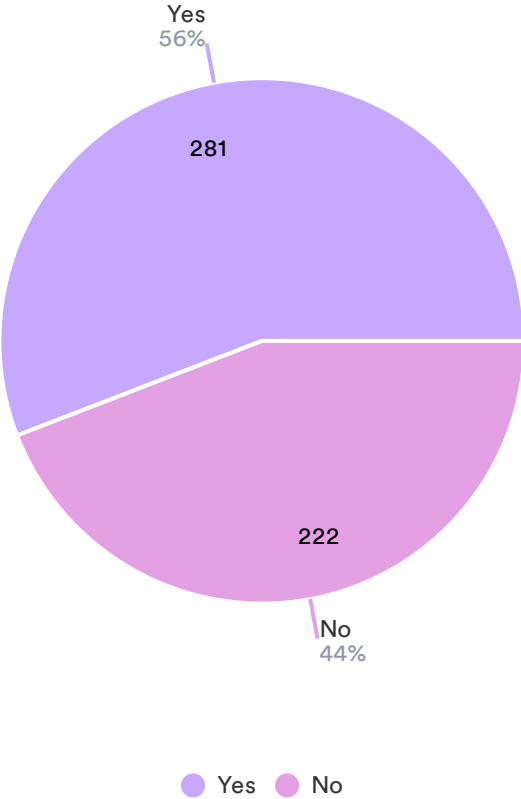

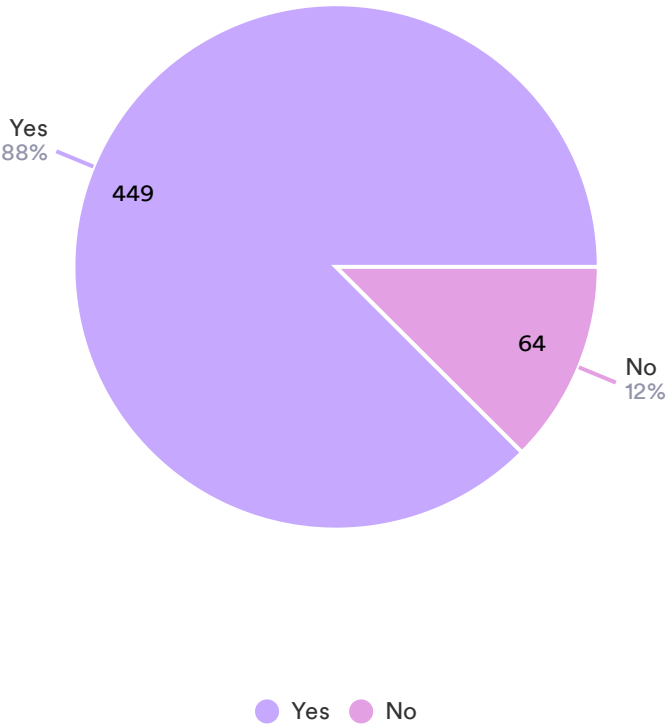
